Haggai received a message from God for those who could remember the former temple of Solomon that had been destroyed and were discouraged with the new temple that was being built. They thought this new temple was "nothing" in relationship to Solomon's (2:3). But God told them He would bless it with greater glory than He had the first one. Only a few years after the temple was completed the people became lax in their worship and work for the Lord. So God through Malachi challenges the people, "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," Says the LORD of hosts, 'If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.'

2016 is behind us now and the New Year offers many promises and blessings for us as a family of God's people. Our theme for 2017 is "Fill This
