Greetings from Zimbabwe in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! This message serves to thank you for your great support of the Lord's work in Zimbabwe. First and foremost, we want to say 2017 will stand out as one year which ended with unprecedented political developments and potential for great social and economic turnaround in this country. After wallowing in poverty for the past 37 years, no one in Zimbabwe ever dreamt that the previous era of iron grip on power, propensity for ruthless use of force and extra judicial repression would end so quickly. But it did. The new President has promised to breathe in new life to the economy in tandem with accepted international political, economic and democratic principles.
