THINGS TO KNOW/REMEMBER

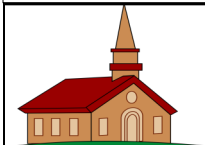

Our Relationship to the World *by Jason T Carter*

Paul wrote that Christians were "not to keep company with sexually immoral people. Yet I certainly did not mean with the sexually immoral people of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world" (1 Corinthians 5:9-10). He reminded the Ephesians that before their conversion, "you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ" (Ephesians 2:12-13).

How did those Christians become Christians? "How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?...So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:14,17). It has been said that

every Christian is a walking sermon, so we should carefully consider our conduct when we are in the company of those who are outside the church. Our example and influence could be what leads them to Christ, but it could also be what drives them away.

With these things in mind, let us consider the Lord's teaching as it refers to His disciples' relationship to the world: "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

Greetings from Zimbabwe in the mighty name of our Lord Jesus Christ! "Ask the Lord for rain. In time of the latter rain. The Lord will make flashing clouds; He will give them showers of rain, grass in the field for everyone." Zechariah 10:1. God has answered our prayers for rain. Heavy rains are currently pounding all areas of Zimbabwe night and day and all streams and rivers are running with water. Crops in all rural areas are also looking good. Rural farmers have already started harvesting

wild vegetables like delele (oora) and ulude which are used as relish. Pastures for livestock have also turned green. If the rains continue, farmers will start harvesting their crops in April this year after years of drought. We praise the Lord!
