DECEMBER MONTHLY REPORT, PART 1

It is our prayer that these reports will find you well. 2017 has come and gone. We are very thankful to our heavenly Father who guided us throughout the year. December 2017 was a very busy month with lots of activities.

Baptisms

We are happy to inform you that a total of 12 souls gave their lives to the Lord and were baptized. This brings the total of those baptized since 2002 to 2759 not 2055 as I erroneously indicated in my other previous report. Those baptized in December include an 85 old man Zenzo Nyoni who was baptized at Chapo together with his wife who is 78. The other six were baptized by brother Thomas Mpanduki in

Gokwe, two were baptized by brother Jacob and Nqobizitha and two by brother Laimon Siachakupa in Binga. We give all praise to the Lord!

Mnundu

The Lord provided us an opportunity to preach to parents and pupils at Mnundu Primary School. I had been invited to speak about Early Development Childhood Education Program. They invited me on the basis that I am a former broadcaster and teacher. I then used this opportunity to also preach Christ and Him crucified and explained the five steps which lead to salvation that are: hearing the Gospel-Rom 10:17, believing that Christ died for our sins-John 3:16, repenting from sin-13:3, Confess-

ing-Rom 10:10, and obeying the Lord through baptism-Mark 16:16. I also took the opportunity of presenting to the school two boxes of pencils. We received these pencils in a last Container sent by brother Dorian Flynn and Partners for Africa in February 2016. The head of the school, staff and students were very grateful indeed. They thanked the Church of Christ for this great gift because many rural parents cannot afford to buy pencils and other educational materials for their children.
