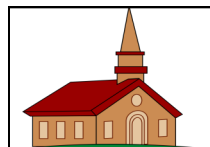


BUILDING FUND

Rejected and Broken *by Tim Dooley*

The final chapters of the prophecy of Zechariah share the sad truth of the rejection of the Messiah. Zechariah serves as an image of the Good Shepherd whom the people refused to follow in contrast to the evil shepherds that the sheep allowed to feed them. The staves of the Good Shepherd, Beauty and Bands, were broken.

For many the same situation exists today but they are blind to its reality. Sin separates us from God (Isaiah 55:1-2) and when we allow ourselves to be fed by evil, covetous, and worldly desires we turn away from the grace and unity that secure us. This is true individually of all men, but it is also true of many congregations. The grace

and unity that binds us together with God as His children, as part of His family is broken when we follow false teachings and practices and not His divine word which He has sent to Guide us.

The decision is simple: The sinner must submit to the Good Shepherd in repentance (Acts 17:30), confession (Matthew 10:32-33), and baptism for the remission of your sins (Acts 2:38). The child of God must then faithfully follow the Good Shepherd who loved us and gave His life for us! The church that has fallen away must repent (Revelation 2-3). Where do we stand today? Greetings from Zimbabwe in the mighty name
of our Lord Jesus Christ! "Ask the Lord for
rain. In time of the latter rain. The Lord will
make flashing clouds; He will give them show-
ers of rain, grass in the field for everyone."
Zechariah 10:1. God has answered our prayers
for rain. Heavy rains are currently pounding all
areas of Zimbabwe night and day and all
streams and rivers are running with water.
Crops in all rural areas are also looking good.
Rural farmers have already started harvesting

wild vegetables like delele (oora) and ulude
which are used as relish. Pastures for livestock
have also turned green. If the rains continue,
farmers will start harvesting their crops in April
this year after years of drought. We praise the
Lord!
