**BE HOLY** *by Jason T Carter*

The word "holy" is defined in several ways in *Thayer's Greek Lexicon*, including, "pure, sinless, upright," and, "set apart for God, to be, as it were, exclusively his." Jesus is identified as "holy" in the Scriptures (Mark 1:23-24; Luke 1:35; Acts 3:14-15; 4:27-30). Jerusalem was called "the holy city" (Matthew 4:5); inspired men of old were called "holy prophets" (Luke 1:70; 2 Peter 3:2); the celestial beings in heaven are "His holy angels" (Matthew 25:31); Paul writes of "the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 3:15). And, of course, the third Person of the Godhead is the Holy Spirit.

As Christians, we are not only expected to be holy, we are commanded to be holy. How important is holiness in the life of a child of God (Hebrews 12:14; Matthew 5:8)? Just as the Hebrews writer says faith is needed to please God (Hebrews 11:6), in 12:14 he says that holiness is required to "see the Lord."

What can we do to help ourselves be holy as God is holy?

What do the following Scriptures suggest?

- Psalm 1:1-2 - be careful where you walk, stand, and sit, and meditate on God's Word
- 1 Corinthians 10:12-13 - watch out for temptation, and recognize God's "way of escape"
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 - choose your friends wisely
- 2 Timothy 2:22 - run away from sin and run toward righteousness
- 1 John 1:9 - recognize our sin, confess it and repent
- Romans 12:1-2 - commit yourself fully to God's will
- Philippians 3:12-16 - be motivated by the goal of heaven

The more time we spend in the Scriptures, the better equipped we will be to guard against sin and live the holy life God demands (2 Timothy 3:16-17). As we go about our lives this week, let us make a concentrated effort to lose our minds, and allow Christ's attitude of holiness be in us.

### **DECEMBER MONTHLY REPORT, PART 2**

#### **Rural Preaching**

We had other preaching trips to Gcabayi and Filabusi. We had only three preaching trips in December because our truck which we nicknamed ' Gospel Beaver' broke down. The rear wheel came off while we were driving to Stanhope. We praise the Lord because the truck did not overturn but was damaged. We thank our brothers and sisters at Rainbow Church of Christ in Alabama who upon hearing about this accident reacted swiftly by providing funds which we used to fix the truck. May our good Lord bless you all! The truck is now back on the road.

#### **Visiting the sick**

We did visit the sick at Mpilo and United Bulawayo Hospitals respectively. We prayed and encouraged them to trust the Lord even during these hard times. We also presented kids at a pediatric ward with small Christmas gifts. Yes, we saw some smiles especially

when these little ones received some candies! Some managed to sing the familiar song: Jesus Loves Me. Oh! kids are very sweet! We have a kid Chilongezo Munengi, who is now six years old and has stomach cancer. We have been helping Chilo since 2013 with hospital expenses. Our brothers and sisters in Canada have all along been paying for his medical bills. We are happy that Chilo was discharged to go home for Christmas and will be back at Mpilo towards the end of this month. His father brother Eilliam is a preacher at Manjolo Church of Christ. Brother Milton McArthur jr met him during our rural preaching trip to Binga when he visited Zimbabwe with brother Craig King some few years back.

#### **Prayers for the Rain and New Year**

On 31 December 2017, 3 congregations, namely: Sailorjack, Chesa and Stanhope prayed for rain at Peterson. The crops were wilting under the scorching

sun. We are happy to tell you that the Lord answered our prayers. On 1January 2018, God opened the skies and that area received very heavy downpour which filled rivers and dams. The rains left many villagers dumpfounded and praising the Lord! True, God answers prayers!
