Does It Make a Difference? by James Dougal

Many choices in our lives can be answered by saying, "I don't care, and does it make a difference?" Things like: the color of our house, or car, or the kind of car we drive, or what kind or color of clothes we wear. Many times we decide these things according to personal preference. Some prefer certain colors or certain styles to others. Sometimes we ask other people what they think, "Should I wear this or cut my hair like that?" We often ask, "What do you think I should do?"

In matters of religion there are some things we can ask of others, "What do you think?" For example: the color of our carpet, what time should we begin Bible Study, or should we have a potluck dinner. But in matters where the Bible informs us certainly about things through command, necessary inference or apostolic example, these things must be observed! For example, what church? How to enter the church? How do we worship? What do we call ourselves? Can I marry, divorce and remarry as I choose? Other example could be cited to illustrate the point I am making.

Some people get into trouble when they confuse these two areas of concern. All too often people take something clearly taught and make it a matter of "What do you think we should do?" instead of asking God what they should do. But this is not a new phenomenon. Notice several scriptures with me. In Exodus 11:7 God told the Israelites that the final plague would be devastating to Egypt, but not to God's people because God put "differences between the Egyptians and Israel." God did this because He considered Israel special in His sight. Then notice Leviticus 10:10-11. Here the Lord said to Aaron, "And that ye may put difference between holy and unholy, and between unclean and clean; And that ye may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD hath spoken unto them by the hand of Moses." In chapter 11 God gave them the examples they needed so they would know what was unclean and what was clean so they had no doubts. God told them in verses 44-45 to, "be holy; for I am holy," they were to sanctify themselves and defile not themselves with any unclean thing. All this symbolized to them that ceremonial cleanness of the body equaled holiness on their part and cleanness of their heart with God.

You may be asking, "What's the point so far?" The answer is in Ezekiel 22:26, "Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean..." God is telling His people that they will be carried into captivity to Babylon because they thought to themselves, "Does it make a difference what we do religiously?" They failed to keep separate the things they wanted to do from the things God wanted them to do. They blurred the lines between the things holy (what God authorized) and the things unclean (what they wanted to do). They failed to respect the scriptures.

Many today are guilty of the same thing. God, in His word, said that there was only one church (Matt. 16:18; Eph. 4:4-5). Many fail to put difference between Christ's church and the man-made denominations, again blurring the lines. Many fail to put difference between the entry requirements to the church as clearly taught in the New Testament but many pick out and apply only those things they believe are needed (Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; Matt. 10:32-33; Rom. 10:9-10; Luke 13:3, 5).

People fail to make a difference between their way and God's way: of worshipping Him; the organization of the church; of marriage, divorce and remarriage; of the name we are to wear; etc. When God tells us in the New Testament things He requires of us, it is our obligation to keep separate, to keep distinct these things and not blur the lines between what He has said and the things we may want to do. We must realize that as God punished His people in the Old Testament times for this sin of not keeping a difference between things holy and things unholy, won't He punish us as well?
