WHO IS GREATEST *by Tim Dooley*

In response to the question asked by His disciples about "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:1), Jesus juxtaposes the contrast seen in human nature between greatness and service in his discourse about children and the kingdom. He taught His disciples to be humble and forgiving. Yet soon after this teaching these same men tried to forbid the approach of little children to Jesus, a rich man refuses to serve others and follow the Lord, and Peter asks what the faithful will receive (to which Jesus tells the parable of the laborers in the vineyard, teaching that all receive the same reward). Then the mother of James and John come to Jesus with her sons and asks a prominent place for them with Jesus in the kingdom. When the

others hear it they are filled with outrage, jealousy, and resentment. So Jesus pulls them aside and tells them that to be great in the kingdom they must humble themselves and serve each other.

We live in an age of obscene pride, jealousy, and covetousness. Churches are divided, marriages broken, and nations warring and degenerating all due to the sin of selfishness. Do we want to be considered great in the kingdom? Or do we just want to be seen as great among the world? If the latter you already have your reward. But if the former, the greatest reward awaits you! Serve God, serve others, and ask yourself, "Am I greater than the Lord?" (Matthew 20:28).

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

2018 PREACHING PROGRAMS

Last week we held a Preachers and their Wives meeting at Nkulumane 12. We looked at two issues.

1. How can we grow the church? We all agreed to try and apply the following:

- Use the WBS Courses in teaching the Bible to as many people as possible.
 - Put together a missionary team which will do evangelism work in various areas.
 - Prepare good vibrant sermons and improve our sermon delivery.
 - Improve youth teaching programs and help them participate in various activities
 - Choose good teachers at leadership seminars who will help Christians to stick to the Bible
2. 2018 programs:

(a) This year we shall have five combined fellowship Sundays to fortify each other's faith in Bulawayo.

(b) The annual Matebeleland Gospel meeting will be at Kumbudzi in Mtshabezi at the end of October where Jacob and Nqobizitha are preaching. The brethren at Mtshabezi requested for this event last year.

(c) The ladies told us that they had agreed to have their ladies Matebeleland Lectureship at Bulawayo Central in April.

(d) This year's International Lectureship will be held in Malawi at the end of March.

I thought it is good for you to know that this team of preachers which has dedicated itself to save lives of people spiritually has a very busy schedule. Please pray for us and for the growth of the Lord's church in Zimbabwe. We should "work while it is still Day".

STELLA IS SICK

Stella is sick. Almost all her teeth are painful and some are loose. She is experiencing excruciating

pain when eating. This comes after she had two of her teeth removed some two months back. Secondly, sometimes she wakes up in the morning with a swollen face, tongue, feet or palms and we do not know why. At first we thought she had allergy. We suspect that probably her kidneys are not functioning properly. We are trying to find funds for her to go and consult her doctor in South Africa soon. Please pray for her.

Today we worshipped with the brethren at Ntabazinduna. Some Christians had gone to attend a political rally at Ntabazinduna centre. I preached and urged all Christians to be soul winners Matthew 28:18ff. Such rallies are now becoming numerous as politicians seek to be elected. No official dates for elections have been selected. We also attached a picture of our truck crossing an old small bridge built in the mid 1800s.
