Are You Open to Sacrificially Giving to God? by Dennis Nosal

The purpose of this article is to talk about stewardship. I wanted to get just the right passage that would talk about how we should be faithful stewards of the blessings that God has given to us. I thought of using Matthew 6:19-21, "Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal; But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also." This passage teaches us that the things of this world are just temporal and all the things we accumulate in this world will pass away. It teaches us that heaven is a place of everlasting joy and happiness. It is a place that will never see corruption. It teaches us that we can see evidence of a faith in God or lack thereof by the way we give.

However, that passage may not get the message across that I truly want to deliver. So I thought of 2 Corinthians 9:7, "Every man according as he purposed in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver." This passage teaches us that giving is not something we do haphazardly, but we must decide in our hearts how much we should give. As a Christian we have made a commitment to Christ and to serve Him. The gift we give to God is a measure of that commitment. We're reminded in this passage that we should give cheerfully and not because we feel forced to give. A cheerful giver is like a tree bearing fruit. The natural fruit is produce from inside the tree. A cheerfully given gift is produced from the love a servant has for his Savior.

Giving grudgingly is likened to someone taking a stapler and fastening a piece of fruit to the tree. The tree did not bear this fruit and it will soon rot and fall to the ground. This passage too, teaches us about stewardship, but I'm still looking for another one that might drive home the point I want to make.

Then I thought of John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believed in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life." I think this is the passage I wanted to share with you. Christ gave His life so that we could have eternal life. What better motivation could we have to give cheerfully and to give liberally to our Lord than this? Christ paid it all for us. What have we done for our Lord?
