GO AND TELL *by Tim Dooley*

The last chapter of the book of Matthew is all about a mission. A mission to tell people the Good News of the resurrected Savior. The two women at the empty tomb of Jesus are told to "go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead" (v. 7). Verse 8 tells us that they ran to tell the disciples and Jesus met them in the way. Jesus then tells them to go and tell his brethren to meet him in Galilee. In contrast the soldiers are compelled to lie about the risen Jesus and what they had seen. Finally, Jesus meets with his disciples and issues the

final charge to go and "make disciples" of all nations," baptizing them," and to "teach them" to observe all He had commanded.

When we go, teach, and do his will, he meets us in the way and never leaves our side. When we go and make disciples they will become the children of God and receive the forgiveness of sins. When we go teaching we encourage a faithful walk that leads to everlasting life. When we go. If we go! Go, my friends, and be faithful! [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

DIRE NEED

Today, brother Dumisani and I worshipped with the congregation at Enyandeni in Gwanda almost 100kms from Bulawayo. My text for my sermon was I Cor 15:58. I urged Christians to stand firm in the Lord and abound in His work. Then during announcements 13 families indicated that they were in dire need of food. Their families came to the worship service hungry. That touched our hearts and I then donated \$78 which I gave to the congregation so that they may buy mealie meal for these families. A 10kg bag of mealie meal currently costs \$6 in some shops. These families were very grateful indeed! This shows the dire situation in some rural congregations. After the service, we visited some of their fields. Some crops have

wilted permanently and even if it rains today, these farmers will get nothing. Therefore I am supporting the suggestion that a drought relief fund be set to assist our brothers and sisters who are looking at a terrible drought looming in the horizon. See pictures!
