This year marks the sixth year that I have been blessed to be able to attend the lectures at Freed Hardeman University. I am thankful to the elders and members of the Point Pleasant Church of Christ for making this a part of my spiritual growth and development. I hope it serves both you and I well as we strive to more deeply understand the Lord's will for us and ultimately spend eternity together with Him (and each other) in heaven when this life is over.

As in past years, the experience was such an encouragement to Colleen and I. We were able to spend time with, fellowship, and worship with so many friends. As always the lessons we were able to hear were encouraging and educational from a deep well of biblical, faithful scholars. I will never forget these intimate moments with loving brethren with hundreds of other Christians busily scurrying about us. I was also blessed to lead a prayer before brother Eric Owens spoke to us one morning in one of the balcony classes.

The week at Freed ended on Thursday evening with a wonderful and encouraging message by brother Doug Burleson "God's Heart Establishes." After his brother-in-law, and my good friend, Mike Johnson lead us in song, Doug's father, Ted Burleson, lead us in prayer. Doug then expounded unto us that while we cannot "know it all," "do it all," or "fulfill all things" there is One who can. He can establish in us a heart that shines His light in the presence of all men, unlike those who have a tenebrific heart.

We left not wanting the week to end and shocked at how quickly the week had passed. But we left renewed and eager to get back home to our family (physical and spiritual). Reminded that He is our "All In All" and more willing than ever to let Him have His way with me.

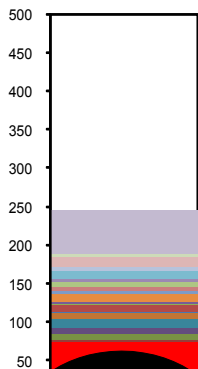
