Purity (Leviticus 21-25) by Tim Dooley

Reading the book of Leviticus reminds us of the importance God placed on the purity of His priesthood and the children of Israel. The history of Israel's people is also a reminder of the consequences of impurity (Ezekiel 36:16-21). God is righteous and just and He does not overlook or tolerate impurity.

All Christians today live as both the children of God and as priests (1 Peter 2:5-9), but unlike the Levitical priesthood's requirements to be without blemish in the flesh God wants the Christian priesthood to be pure in heart and mind. "But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am holy'" (1 Peter 1:15-16).

On a personal level the apostle Paul com-

mands Timothy to not allow anyone to "despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity" (1 Timothy 4:12). The imperative here is followed with a warning that, "no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God" (Ephesians 5:5).

Isaiah 1:18 invites all to "Come now, and let us reason together," says the Lord, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool." Jesus can cleanse us, purify us, and save us through our obedience (1 Peter 1:22). But we must also be striving daily to draw near to God, cleanse our hands, and purify our hearts (James 4:8). ## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Beloved in the Lord  
 The year 2017 began very well indeed when we led adult Bible classes on Anxiety. No one knows what 2017 has in store for us. For example, Our economies are facing a myriad of challenges with few young people getting jobs, many struggling to make ends meet, we have sick relatives, some have lost beloved ones and bread winners while the drought in third world countries have caused misery and despair. Such scenarios are fertile grounds for anxiety. We then started the year by preparing lessons which aimed at helping Christians find ways of overcoming this problem. In a nutshell, anxiety involves someone experiencing feelings of uneasiness or worry. However, the Bible's viewpoint on anxiety is

two-fold: one is liability and the other is an asset. What helped King David cope when he faced anxiety? Psalm 13:2. He poured out his heart to God in prayer, trusting fully in God's loyal love. Psalm 13:5; 62:8. God invites us to unburden ourselves to Him. 1 Peter 5:7. In other words, we should allay anxieties by addressing them in a practical way. Paul felt "anxiety for all congregations," he then worked hard to comfort and encourage those for whom he was concerned (11 Cor 11:28). In that respect, his anxiety proved to be an asset, for it moved him to extend needed help. The same can be true of us. The opposite attitude--apathy and indifference have no place in the life of a Christian. (Prov 17:17. Phil 2:4).
