We're glad that you were able to join us this morning in worship to God. Please let us know if you have questions we can answer and also let us know how we can serve you!

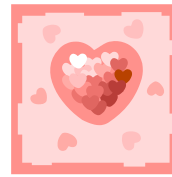
CONGRATULATIONS

Are You Ready? *By Tim Dooley*

It seems like every time we go on a trip we forget something. Several years ago when Colleen and I went to the Freed Hardeman lectureship we took several French cuff shirts. When we got there we realized that we had left all my cuff links at home. This year when we got to Jackson we realized we had left all of my shoes at home so we had to buy new shoes when we got there. And before anyone asks: We have forgotten her things at times as well and I say "we" and not "me" because, well, we would forget much more if she wasn't involved. None-the-less, even before we ever step out of the house to go anywhere I usually ask each member of my family if they are ready to go (I also ask myself this same question), yet someone still seems to forget something.

Clearly we want to make sure that we have made adequate preparation and have done everything we need to have done before leaving. Spiritually it is even more critical. While one can usually stop and pick up a forgotten item (There's good reason hotels usually sell a number of little items for the forgetful), like a set of cuff links or a pair of shoes, once we leave this

life it will be too late to "fix" the situation. Far too many people leave this life unprepared or not "adequately" prepared! Jesus makes it clear in Matthew 25:1-13 that preparation for eternal life and faithful service are prerequisites for a successful journey from this life to the next. And the time to prepare is now (2 Corinthians 6:2), for we don't know when the Lord is going to return (Matthew 24:42). It will happen without warning and when we least expect it (1 Thessalonians 5:2; 2 Peter 3:10).

Are you ready to go? One must have faith and trust in the Lord and His word for a successful journey (John 6:29), we must pack our lives with repentance (Acts 26:20), we must fill our lives with confession (Matthew 10:32-33), and be baptized for the remission of your sins to enter into the ship that sails to heaven's shore (Acts 2:38). Then we must be faithful in works of faith and righteousness, preparing and ensuring for the hearing those beautiful words, "Well done."
