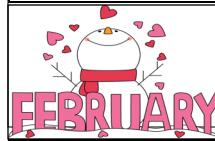
SYMPATHY EXTENDED

The Law, Pattern, and Nature of God by Tim Dooley

There has been so much misunderstanding about the nature of God and His law among men that the simple truth isn't always so apparent today even among the children of God. The law of God in the Old Testament (i.e. the Law of Moses) was not about vengeance, but justice. It was in great part God's way protecting the helpless and innocent, providing for the needy, and blessing the righteous. He gave the children of Israel a pattern to follow in all things. As God continued to direct His people through Moses He gave them very detailed plans so that they would be able to fulfill His will. Stop and think of

just how thoughtful the God of heaven is who does not leave His people without guidance and instruction.

He too has given us a law for justice, protection, provision, and blessing, as well as a pattern to follow that we may remain in a covenant relationship with Him. Indeed, if we love the Master, and our families, we will allow Him to pierce our ear, and we will serve Him faithfully forever (21:5-6). How sad it is when anyone turns from the Lord's instruction and leans on their own understanding (Proverbs 3:5). Be thankful, be obedient, and be faithful! [Tim]

Preaching and teaching

We continued preaching and teaching in various congregations throughout the Matabeleland Province. We really thank you so much our brothers and sisters for your unwavering support which enables us to reach many lost souls with the Gospel Truth and also fortify the faith of His saints. May our good Lord continue blessing you.

Food Relief

We managed to distribute food to 53 families. Rural families have an average of five people. This means that 265 individual persons benefit from this food distribution. We praise the Lord for encouraging

His saints to help the poor at this juncture.

Funerals

Jacob, Nqobizitha and I assisted several families lay their departed. During these sad times, we always comfort the bereaved and also remind mourners about the brevity of life and how we should prepare for eternity as our inevitable day of departure gets closer.

Rains

Zimbabwe is experiencing a very hot spell. This has caused the early planted maize to wilt permanently. If we get good rains soon, the late planted crops will survive.

Family News

My wife, Stella is not feeling well. She was

bitten by a tiny poisonous insect. Initially we thought she was bitten by a mosquito but her leg began to swell and developed a wound which quickly grew bigger. We suspect that she was bitten by a poisonous spider. She has gone to South Africa for treatment. Please remember her in your prayers.
