A Sad Saga (2 Chronicles 31-36) by Tim Dooley

The end of the Chronicles of the kings of Israel and Judah marks the end of the Hebrew Bible. And while in our Old Testament we still have much to learn from the poets and prophets this ending serves as a reminder that this inspired book is first and foremost a story about God and His relationship with His creation.

What should be evident to us from the Old Testament is:

- The Lord God is the one true and living God of all creation.
- He is a God of covenant and desires to have a relationship with His creation.
- He is a covenant God.
- He is a God of both justice and mercy.

There are inescapable consequences to failing to keep His will.

Each king was said to either have done that which was right in the sight of the Lord or that which was evil. Each had free will to choose.
