Consider and Obey *By Tim Dooley*

In 1 Samuel 12 the children of Israel are commanded by Samuel to "consider how great things [God] has done for you" (12:24). And when Saul sinned in not completely destroying the Amalekites (Saul skirts the issue, blames the people, and acts like a big baby) Samuel asks the rhetorical question, "Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams" (15:22). Considering that the Old Testament has been preserved for us, in part, to remind us and teach us about the relationship between God and man (Romans 15:4; Romans 11:21-24; 1 Corinthians 10:11), we are reminded of the importance of remembering what great things God has done for us and the necessity to be faithful in our obedience to Him.

When we focus on the successes and blessings of others it is so easy to be come envious and forget just how good God has been to us. When we are feeling sorry for ourselves its easy to forget how blessed we are and ignore the needs of those around us who are needier than we may be. Focusing on God's blessings in our lives not only helps us to maintain a proper perspective and relationship with our neighbors but it also helps us maintain a right relationship with the Father. Consider the physical blessings He has blessed us

all with. The sun and the rain, springtime and the autumn, and the abundance of His creation. Think of your health, wealth, education, job, income, family, friends, and truly the list could go on. As my Grandma Healea used to say, "If you really start to count your blessings you'd never stop." And shouldn't we!

Also consider the spiritual blessings that have been given to all men. The inspired word of God (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:3), the sacrifice of His Son upon the cross (John 3:16), and a hope of being saved from sin and death (John 3:17). Yet consider that only those who accept the spiritual blessings He has offered are going to enjoy the benefits. If you have not obeyed Him through repentance (Acts 17:30), confession (Romans 10:10), and baptism (Mark 16:16) why do you continue to reject His love?

If you are a Christian consider the blessings He has bestowed on us: assurance (Hebrews 10:22), the church (Mark 10:30), and a home prepared for us by Jesus himself (John 14:1-3). Are you faithful and are you eagerly anticipating His return?

What great blessings God has bestowed upon us today and yet so few take note and obey Him. "Consider how great things [God] has done for you" and respond in faithful obedience and humility. And be faithful! [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Last Saturday, we had a leadership workshop at Stanhope in Nyamandlovu District. Stanhope is about 80 kms west of Bulawayo. The workshop was attended by 9 men. Mthokozisi presented a lesson on Sermon Preparation, Siphon Pitfalls of a Preacher and I delivered a lesson on Leadership Qualities. We also had a question and answer session after the presentation of all lessons. We then provided them with food for lunch. This year, We Have decided to conduct such leadership Workshops in various congregations throughout Matebeleland

North and South. This will enable many local men to attend and it will also cut costs of providing them with transport to the WBS Office in Bulawayo. We are also thinking of simultaneously conducting ladies' Bible lessons which will be taught by preachers' wives. At Stanhope, their church building which is in the background, is also used by the local community as a classroom for children.
