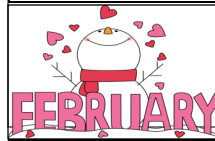
MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS

Because of their impatience the children of Israel sinned against God and caused Aaron to sin as well. In Exodus 23:1-2 God gave two instructions: 1) You shall not bear a false report, and 2) You shall not follow the masses in doing evil. Aaron violates both of these commands. However, in Exodus 34:6-7 we are told about the nature of God: His longsuffering and forgiveness, but also His justice and that there are conse-

quences for our actions.

It seems like whenever the children of Israel were idle they sinned. They were most faithful when they stayed busy doing the work of God. Is this true of us as well. Does idleness lead to sinfulness? Passages to reflect on: Proverbs 19:15; Ecclesiastes 10:18; Ezekiel 16:49; Matthew 20:1-16; 1 Timothy 5:13. Stay busy and be faithful! [Tim]
