Disqualified by Tim Dooley

Last Sunday (February 26, 2012) was an historic day in Fort Worth, Texas for the Cowtown Marathon and Scott Downard. The Cowtown Marathon featured the gathering of thousands of registered participants on the grounds of Will Rogers Memorial Center. Downard, a 25-year-old from Norman, Oklahoma, crossed the finish line first at 2:31:40, shattering last year's record of 2:44:27, and overcoming stiff head winds and a hilly course.

And while Mr. Downard finished first, and in record time, he did not win. Kolin Styles, who crossed the finish line second with a record setting time of 2:37:53, was officially declared the winner. Mr. Downard was disqualified when he acknowledged that the bib he was wearing belonged to a friend who couldn't make the race. He had run the race and crossed the finish line with another person's number. He himself was not a registered participant for the race.

Everyone understands why Mr. Downard was disqualified and he himself, without protest, admitted that he was not a registered participant and did not deserve the record time or the win. Yet when it comes to the spiritual race and victory in Jesus that so many hope for the same standard doesn't seem to apply. People want to do things their own way. They argue that we are all on different courses striving for the same goal. The requirements laid forth in God's Word are ignored, disputed, and even altered.

The apostle Paul by inspiration all should run the Christian race in such a way as to obtain the prize God has promised (1 Corinthians 9:24). But he also says, "if anyone competes in athletics, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules (2 Timothy 2:5).

Jesus said, "If you love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15). 1 John 5:3 states, "For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome." There are many who say they love God, who claim to be running the race, but are not doing so lawfully. They are not keeping the commandments of God. There are many who will hear Jesus say to them in Judgment, "I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity" (Matthew 7:23). Many who never lawfully registered and competed for the heavenly reward!

To become a Christian one must understand the pattern of the Lord (Ephesians 5:17), we must believe in the pattern of Jesus as God's Son (John 8:24), we must obey the pattern by turning from your sins (Acts 17:30-31) we must obey the pattern by confessing your faith in Christ (Matthew 10:32-33), we must obey the pattern by being baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). Then we must live a faithful life guided by the pattern of God's Word (1 Corinthians 15:58).

Some begin the race and then grow weary, faint, drop out, and resign. But the race is still being run and there is still time for you to re-enter and finish. To be restored to the race for salvation these individuals must turn from their sins (Acts 8:22) and confess those sins to God and pray for forgiveness (1 John 1:9; Acts 8:22).

Are you lawfully entered and running the race? Be faithful! [Tim]
