How Far or How Near *by Tim Dooley*

One of the great lessons of Christian living we learn here from the apostle Peter. We know that while Peter was near Jesus he was strong, brave, and faithful. He promised to not ever be offended even if all others were (Mark 14:29). His fervent insistence that even if he had to die he would never deny influenced the others to say likewise (Mark 14:31). In the Garden of Gethsemane, standing next to the Lord, he was ready to fight and give his life (Mark 14:47). But in one of the saddest passages in all of Scripture we read that after Jesus was led away Peter "followed afar off" (Mark 14:54). And because of the

distance he put between himself and the Lord he denied Jesus three times, just as Jesus had said.

How closely are we walking with Jesus? How far off have we followed? The Hebrew writer said, "Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water" (Hebrews 10:22). "Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *ye* sinners; and purify *your* hearts, *ye* double minded" (James 4:8). Be faithful my friends! [Tim]

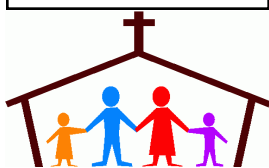

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

I am happy to inform you that this morning at 8am our daughter Lithule went into an operation theatre /surgery. The doctors successfully removed a catheter in her left upper arm. It was inserted some years back for use during her dialysis. It was giving her so much pain but now that pain is gone. We give glory to God! We hope she will recover soon. Please remember her in your prayers.

In His Service, Velaphi

Our trip to South Africa for medical checks was very successful indeed. I was allowed to go with Stella into the examination room where medical machines were plucked onto her body and her health graph was printed out by a computer. Dr Scheppers said Stella needs more treatment to remove too much

acid which is still in her blood. The doctor said Acid is now 3,080 and should drop to 3,021 level. She is slowly getting better. However the oxygen content in her lungs is weak. What causes this acid? She said diet: Eating sweet & sour food. Her body does not respond well to these types of foods. All starches out, rice and maize sadza (staple food). Her cholesterol is also a bit high. Thus she should steam her food while cooking. Coffee was also ruled out. Thus she will be under Dr Scheppers observation for the next four days. Please remember her in your prayers.

On my part, the medical examination went very well. But my doctor also indicated that my cholesterol was a bit high and my blood sugar level too. My doctor encouraged me to stop eating red meat, sweet things and do lots of exercise. More blood tests were

taken and I will go back again next month Lord willing for the results. I came back to Bulawayo on Sunday morning and attended the Fellowship Sunday at Bulawayo Central. It was attended by almost 300 Christians. I taught an adult Bible class on Heb 2:1-4. "Paying closer attention to what we have heard lest we drift away." Then in the evening I preached at Morningside at the funeral awake of brother Mzizi of Bhala in Zhilo where brother Jacob and Nqo are preaching. He passed on this previous weekend. The body has been taken to Zhilo this afternoon for burial at 9am tomorrow. I will leave very early tomorrow morning for this burial. Please remember bro Mzizi's family in your prayers. I am not sure but guess bro Mzizi was in his 80s.
