FEBRUARY 2018 MONTHLY REPORTS : PART 1

Preach the Word

I visited my doctor during the previous month of February at Kalafong Medical Centre in Pretoria in South Africa for medical check up. The doctor picked up my medical record card and then looked at me inquisitively and asked: " Mr Mlangeni, are you a preacher?" I said: "yes I am." Then he went on: " It is a long time since I have been to church." I asked him: "why?" He did not give a specific reason but ended up saying: "Why should I? I find no logic in doing so." I was a bit taken back but I pointed out to this doctor some few reasons why we should worship God as we briefly discussed the following : (1) God, our creator, reveals in the Bible, His authentic Word, that it should guide us in our lives (Psalm 119:105). (2) He commands us to worship Him alone, not any created

thing, and that we should always be thankful about His innumerable blessings in our lives (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14; John 4:4. James 1:17). (3) God promises eternal life to those who believe in His Son and are baptized and remain faithful to Him unto death (John 3:16; Mark 16:16; Rev 2:10). I then referred him to the Lord's church at Seeso Street in Attridgeville in Pretoria. Am glad to inform you that this doctor has now started attending the Sunday morning worship service with his family at Seeso. The eternal seed was planted into his heart and the Lord will give the increase. May the Lord be praised! It was indeed a wonderful experience to see this doctor laying down his medical tools and listening to the Gospel Truth.

during the month in review. Eight were baptized by brother Mthokozisi, four were baptized by brother Laimon Siachakuba in Binga and two by brother Thomas Mupanduki in Nembudziya, Gokwe.
