MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

What the Bible teaches us will always be truthful. One of our daily papers has reported that two boys aged 12 and 15 missed death by a whisker while walking back home from school near Chidobi Village close to Victoria Falls. They saw a pride of lions heading their way. When they tried to escape, the lions spotted them and gave chase. The boys quickly climbed a huge tall tree and found a branch where they pitched themselves and clutched at each other lest they fell. When the lions came to this tree, they roared as if they had made a kill and scratched it with their sharp paws. These lions seemed very excited as they went round and round the tree but for some unknown reason never climbed it.

The boys sat still up this tree and never moved an inch. In that process, some buffalo bulls emerged

chasing two lions. Then all the lions scattered and tried to attack these buffaloes from different directions and the fight continued for sometime until they disappeared into the thick forest.
