**On Stephen Hawking and the Reality of God by Jason T Carter**

The Hebrews writer penned, "It is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27).

Stephen Hawking passed from this life into eternity on Wednesday, March 14, 2018. As of 2011, Mr. Hawking did not believe the words of inspiration. In an interview with *The Guardian*, quoted by *USA Today*, the physicist said, "I regard the brain as a computer which will stop working when its components fail. There is no heaven or afterlife for broken down computers; that is a fairy story for people afraid of the dark."

God blessed Mr. Hawking with intelligence, but the man refused to use that blessing to observe the Almighty's creation all around Him and seek the designer of it all. In *The Grand Design*, published in 2010, Mr. Hawking wrote, "Spontaneous creation is the reason there is something rather than nothing, why the universe exists, why we exist. It is not necessary to invoke God to light the blue touch paper and set the universe going."

Sadly, to the best of my knowledge, Mr. Hawking never shed his self-proclaimed atheism. As Christians, we must mourn not only the loss of his brilliant mind but also the eternal state of his soul. We cannot rejoice in the eternal condemnation of the unbelieving, but trust in the righteousness of God. We need to share the desire of the Lord, who is "not willing that any should perish but that all should come to the repentance" (2 Peter 3:9) and strive to reach those with whom we have some influence.

Mr. Hawking said, "Remember to look up at the stars and not down at your feet. Try to make sense of what you see and wonder about what makes the universe exist." Friends, all the answers we need are found in the Holy Scriptures.

"If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God" (Colossians 3:1-3).

### FEBRUARY 2018 MONTHLY REPORTS : PART 2

#### **Report from Jacob and Nqobizitha**

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Hoping this report finds everyone well as we continue working in the Lord's vineyard. We have received some significant rainfalls in the past week but they could not resuscitate the maize crops in the fields because the scorching sun in January had already done much damage.

We started the month on a sad note as brother Moyo one of our Mtshabezi Church leaders passed away, my father, brother Velaphi Mlangeni and I traveled to Mtshabezi about 100 km out of Bulawayo to be with our brethren in time of sorrow and also help with the burial.

On the second first day of the week we worshipped with the Congregation in Dula about 115km out of Bulawayo. It is with great joy to let you know that the rural work continues to grow, our fellow Christians continue holding steadfast to the true Gospel.

We also sent 32 bags of Mealie meal to our needy rural brethren, they sent messages to say thank you very much for the continued love you continue to show just as Jesus did for the needy people Matthew 14 vs 13-21.

The third first day of the week we worshipped with the local Congregation encouraging one another in, hymn praying and reading from the scriptures. On the last first day of the week we worshipped with the Bulawayo Churches of Christ in our Com-

bined Sunday we had a blessed day it is very great that the Churches of Christ and the Preachers here in Zimbabwe continue to be united working together so the name of our father in heaven is glorified.

We ended the week again on a sad note as another one of our rural Congregation leaders from Bhala in the Zhilo area passed away brother Velaphi and my father preached and helped with the burial and I was leading songs throughout the burial.

Thank you very much for your spiritual and financial support which enable us to do all for the Lord.
