GOSPEL MEETING APRIL 24-27 FLYERS IN FOYER

Do It Now *By Tim Dooley*

There is a book by author Brian Tracy entitled, "Eat That Frog!: 21 Great Ways to Stop Procrastinating and Get More Done in Less Time." The idea is that there are a lot of things in life that we have to do and that we don't want to do. So we put off doing what needs to be done. The longer we put off doing what needs to be the harder it gets and the more we procrastinate. The longer you procrastinate the less productive you are. What if you had to eat a live frog every morning and couldn't do anything else until you did? The longer that "live frog" sits there on the plate uneaten the less productive you will be.

Read through the first few chapters of the book of Mark and see how many times you notice adverbs like immediately or straightway. People often put off doing today what they need to do spiritually.

Maybe it is asking someone for forgiveness, maybe it is granting forgiveness and restoring a friend or brother-in-Christ, maybe its admitting we were wrong, maybe it is stopping some sinful or wasteful habit. None of that tastes good and is often unpleasant. But is absolutely necessary for us to become more productive and to grow as God's children.

Maybe you need to repent of sin and ask God to forgive you. Maybe you need to obey the gospel by believing in Jesus enough to trust Him and obey Him, to repent of any sin in your life, confess His name, and be baptized. Former Ohio State football coach Jim Tressel used to say, "You do what you have to do so, you can do what you want to do." What are you waiting for? Do it now, eat that frog!
