## The Love and Mercy of God *by Tim Dooley*

“In the second half of the book of Numbers we continue to see the age-old struggle of mankind striving against God's will. The children of Israel have defeat snatched from the hands of victory as they call on God to deliver their enemy and then turn around and murmur against Him. Balaam has to have a discussion with his donkey in order to hear God and he was a prophet. Balak keeps saying, "Let's try over here." "No?" "Let's try over here..." Is it that hard to hear the Lord and do what He says? We can be hard on these fickle and unfaithful biblical characters, but do we not often act in the same way?

Yet God still cares for and loves His people, and in He begins to make preparation for Israel's

entrance into the Promised Land. God has made provision for us to enter the Promised Land of Heaven.

As we close the book God informs Moses that his life will soon end and he is to give some final instructions to the Children of Israel. A couple things stand out to me in this reading. 1) God loves His people and is concerned for their well-being. 2) God is just and righteous and His judgment needs to be enforced. 3) He expects the people to remain pure and free from evil influences. When the family has wicked and divisive influences among them, that defile the body and pollute the land, it must be cleansed (33:55-56; 35:34). God is faithful, be ye faithful! **[Tim]**

## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Report from Jacob and Ngobizitha Moyo  
 Greetings in the mighty name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ hoping this report finds everyone is well. We continue having a high mortality rate, losing many of our beloved brothers and sisters in Christ especially in the rural areas as we are now forced to travel more trips back and forth to the rural long distances to help with burials, please kindly keep us and our brethren in your prayers.

The first week of the month we had to be involved and helping in two funerals and as one of our sister in Christ from the local Church lost a son and another brother in Christ passed on in Bayethe about 90km out of Bulawayo, thank you very much for your support in the Lord's work that made it possible for us to reach out and help our bereaved in such difficult times.

On the second week of the month we worshipped with two of our Congregations in Mtshabezi the Kumbudzi and the Mazikhelela Churches, it is so encouraging and most humbling to see the brethren continuing holding steadfast to the true Gospel even in difficult times in the Country Romans 8:35-39. We distributed more than 50 bags of Mealie meal to the needy rural brethren there, who sent messages to say thank you very much for the charity you continue to give in their time of need, May the Lord bless all of you.

The third week of the month we lost another sister in Christ in Malungwane about 105 km out of Bulawayo, where we had to also assist preaching words of comfort and a reminder that this world is not our home Phillipians 3:20.

We continued as well with the drip irrigation

ministry visiting gardens and checking how can we assist our brethren who continue working very hard in their gardens to get food as most parts of the Country are in severe drought already.

On the last week of the month we worshipped with the local Congregation encouraging one another in hymns, praying and studying the scriptures.

Dear brethren we would like to let you know that we sincerely appreciate and are so grateful for the opportunity to work with you in bringing lost souls and a lot people closer to Christ we pray that the Lord will continue to strengthen our bond in all good works. Thank you very much for all the support in all the Lord's work and all glory to our father in heaven.
