Except Ye Repent *by Tim Dooley*

The focus in Luke chapters 12-14 is on the cost of discipleship and the faithfulness to God which every disciple must exhibit in order to be rewarded with eternal life. Yet in the midst of these chapters we come upon a well-known verse. A verse we often hear quoted in an invitation at the conclusion of a sermon. Jesus said, "except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish" (Luke 13:3, 5). The application for us is that this warning is not for those of who have never repented; it is a warning to the children of God not compare themselves, and their sins, with the sins of others. Nor is the Christian to seek to justify themselves based upon their own righteousness.

Do we believe that others are so much greater sinners than we ourselves are? It doesn't matter! If we are impenitent in our sins, we will pay the ultimate price of eternal damnation. We need to stop comparing ourselves against the lives of those around us and take a hard look at our lives compared to Christ. Now none of us stack up well against that standard. But the real question is one of attitude. Are we looking at others and feeling good about where we are spiritually? Or are we looking to Christ, falling on our knees in sorrow for our sins, thankful for His mercy and grace, striving to be more like him, and trying to help others to do the same?
