## The Love and Mercy of God *by Tim Dooley*

I received a phone call this past week asking if I could take on an additional speaking assignment at a lectureship that I am supposed to speak on in a few weeks. The need arose because the congregation hosting the lecture program had to take a stand and uninvited one of the speakers. It had come to their attention that the speaker had recently joined in fellowship with a denominational group. After watching the video of the event I was filled with both sadness and righteous indignation. Not only had this preacher left the fellowship of God and the church he had also drug a number of members with him and ultimately the entire congregation for which he has been charged to "preach the truth."

Several times in Deuteronomy 16-20 the children of Israel are reminded to remove sin from the

camp in order to keep the camp pure. Much of our discord today is a direct result of not following this Old Testament example and New Testament command. Had the elders at the above mentioned congregation took a stand against their preacher's false teaching they would have done their divine duty to protect the flock. Sadly they have failed their flock, themselves, and their God. Paul wrote, "Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person" (1 Corinthians 5:13). "Reject a divisive man after the first and second admonition" (Titus 3:10). In order to remain pure and holy as the people of God, the unrepentant sinner must be removed, and we cannot let our personal feelings stand between God and us in doing His will. "A little leaven leavens the whole lump" (1 Corinthians 5:6; Galatians 5:9). Be faithful friends! [Tim]
