He is the God of the Living (Luke 18-20) by Tim Dooley

In answering the Sadducees and their question concerning the resurrection Jesus said God "is not the God of the dead, but of the living" (Luke 20:38). Those who are outside of Christ are said to be dead spiritually and God is not their Lord for they have chosen to follow another. Yet, Jesus came to give us life (John 10:10) and by His death, burial, and resurrection He has made us alive who were once dead when we submit ourselves in obedience to His lordship (Ephesians 2:1; Colossians 2:13).

The inspired apostle Paul said that through baptism we are "raised from the dead" and "should walk in newness of life" (Romans 6:1-6). How can anyone say that baptism isn't essential to our salvation? To be alive from the dead? The question is, "Is He your lord and your God?" He is only the God of the living (those who are obedient and faithful), not the God of those who are dead (those who continue to walk in disobedience and sin). 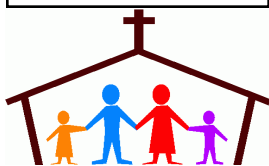

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

My brother, today Stella and I preached and distributed food to the needy Christians at Enyandeni about 80 kms along Johannesburg road. This is where the late brother Leonard Bailey and I used to go and preach before I got married in 1975. Brother and sister Mabuya had worked in this area for years until brother Mabuya passed on in 2012.

Today gogo (grandmother) Mabuya took us to

her field about a mile away. We were surprised to see gogo Mabuya climbing her wooden gate to her field and needed no assistance. We followed suit. At her field, we noticed that very few crops were revived by the late rains. The rest wilted during the heat wave.

Meanwhile, at gogo Mabuya’s homestead, Christians gathered to receive food. After distribution, they expressed so much joy and were

all very thankful indeed.

I finally exhorted them by reading and explaining Rev 2:10. The Devil might bring untold sufferings in our lives but we need to be faithful until we are called by the Lord to our eternal reward.
