Afraid, Astonished, and Offended (Mark 5-7) by Tim Dooley

The story of the Maniac of Gadara has always amazed me. Here is a man that was so crazed and powerful that he could not be tamed or controlled, even with chains. The amazing thing though was that the men of that country did not seem to be afraid of him, rather, they were annoyed. So they tried, time and again, to bind him. When Jesus shows up the demons within the man are cast out into the swine who are subsequently destroyed, now here is the amazing thing, "Then they came to Jesus, and saw the one *who had been* demon-possessed and had the legion, sitting and clothed and in his right mind. And they were afraid" (Mark 5:15).

Why were they afraid? In chapter six the woman with an issue of blood was afraid when she was healed. Herod was afraid when he supposed that John was risen from the dead. The disciples were afraid when they saw Jesus walking on the water. Because of Jesus many were astonished and offended. This is true even today!

A lack of knowledge and sin will cause us to be afraid of that which we have no need to be afraid of. Come to know Jesus, obey him, be faithful to him, and know that "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love" (1 John 4:18).

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

We greet you in the mighty name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We hope and trust that you will enjoy our a summary of the Lord’s work in Zimbabwe during March 2017.

"Your God not Buddah healed you"

These were the words spoken by a Chinese doctor at the International Kidney Disease Center in Shijiazhuang City , China, where our daughter Lithule had gone for treatment of a kidney disease. Do you remember an Israelite girl working for Naaman the Syrian Army Commander? When this girl realized that her Master had tried all he could and failed to get rid of his leprosy, she humbly said to Naaman's wife:"If only my master would see the prophet who is in Samaria! He would cure him of his leprosy." This is exactly what happened to our daughter Lithule. She had tried to get rid of her kidney disease many times and for many years but failed. Then a young man who had the same disease but got help from China said to her: "my sister, please go to this Chinese Disease Center and they will help you." However, our daughter

initially doubted the authenticity of this information and was very reluctant to go. We persuaded her to go and try because in life it is always better to fail trying to do something good than to make the worst mistake of failing to try for fear of failure. She finally agreed but reluctantly though and went together with Stella. When she arrived in China, her kidney function was 13% but after a short time while under treatment, her kidney function shot up to 30%. A group of 16 medical professors, doctors and nurses who were treating her could not believe that Lithule was responding very fast and positively to this cure. Dr John, one of the doctors at this hospital, said to Lithule:" You are a lucky lady! We in China believe in Buddha but I now realize that your Christian God has healed you." Wow! What a confession! What an acknowledgement! Brothers and sisters, we thank you all Churches of Christ in Canada, the United States and Africa for your fervent prayers on behalf of Lithule. God heard your prayers and answered. His name is now being glorified in China. Amen!
