I love baseball season and have been a lifelong fan of the Cincinnati Reds. I look forward, with great anticipation, to the pitchers and catchers reporting early for Spring Training. I follow the "Cactus League" games and as "Opening Day" in Cincinnati approaches I know spring is coming. With warmer weather, ballpark visits, box scores, radio broadcasts and hopes of a World Championship come fall.

I listened again this year to those on television, radio and social media networks taut this as the "Greatest Day" of the year in Cincinnati. "It should be a holiday," some declared." Paul wrote to Timothy, "Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that **love his appearing**" (2 Tim. 4:8).
