On NBC's *RISE* And The Christian's Vigilance by Jason T Carter

Christians must be aware of the world around them. Inspiration teaches, “Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour” (1 Peter 5:8). Our awareness of the world will help to guard us against falling prey to Satan's schemes, and prepare us to help others find God's truth.

NBC premiered a new program called *Rise* in March. The show focuses on Lou Massuchelli, an English teacher put in charge of his high school's drama club. His first act is to announce the production of the controversial musical, *Spring Awakening*, which addresses several issues of teenage sexuality.

Rise includes a male homosexual student, a transgender female transitioning to male, and a straight male who is cast in a role that requires him to kiss another male. All of these are presented as completely normal, acceptable lifestyles to most of the other characters. The few that object are portrayed as narrow-minded people. Show runner Jason Katims released a statement in which he affirmed the producers are “firmly committed to LGBTQ inclusion” and that *Rise* “portrays positive depictions of

LGBTQ characters and stories...with honesty and sensitivity.”

In a recent episode, a parent asked the teacher, “What do you believe in?” Lou responded, “I believe in the kids I teach. I believe in the truth. I believe in helping them to grow up in the sun and not in the shadows,” further reinforcing the character's view that homosexuality and transgenderism should be accepted by everyone. I am reminded of the prophet who cried, “Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; who put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!” (Isaiah 5:20).

Fornication — whether heterosexual or homosexual — is wrong, regardless of age. Transgenderism is wrong. Brother Ben Giselbach published an informative article about transgenderism in 2015 on his website, “Plain Simple Faith” (plainsimplefaith.com/2015/06/transgenderism).

Christians, be aware that many of your co-workers (adults) and classmates (youngsters) believe in the acceptance of deviant sexual behaviors. Be ready to defend the Biblical truth on these matters (1 Peter 3:15; Jude 3).

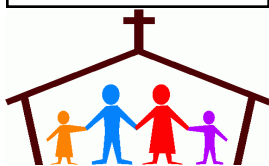

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

You may not believe this but it is true. I failed to go to Malawi. Why? On Wednesday last week, when I was packing my suitcase ready to leave for Malawi, I received a phone call. A brother in Christ said: "Brother Mlangeni, I am sorry to inform you that sister Dube has lost her daughter at Mpilo Hospital who was suffering from throat cancer."

I said: "Oh! I am very sorry for the loss. I hope that all funeral arrangements will proceed smoothly. I am currently packing my suitcase and shall in an hour or two leave for the Malawi Gospel Meeting." The brother then said: "I am sorry brother Mlangeni, the brethren and relatives of the deceased are requesting you to go and break this sad news to sister Dube." Sister Dube is now over 90 and has been in the intensive care unit twice. But each time I visited her in that comma condition, whispered to her ear that I had come to pray for her, she waked up and confounded doctors and some medical staff. So the brethren thought that I was the

right person to break this sad news to her. They thought if someone did, she would collapse and die. Brother Craig, I knelt beside my bed and wept...tears just welled. For the first time I said to our Father: "Why is this happening to me God when I have made so much preparation to attend the Malawi Gospel Meeting?". However inside me I felt that God had a purpose why the brethren had chosen me to go and tell gogo this sad news.

I then drove to Nkulumane and asked brother Nehemiah Nyathi to go with me to sister Dube's home. When we got there, we found that many relatives and brethren had gathered but sister Dube had not been told that her daughter had passed on. We sang few songs and prayed. Then I sat beside her and put my hand over her shoulders and broke the sad news. She failed to understand initially but I repeated this until she grasped the message. She then wept loudly and said: "why did my daughter die? I should have died first...oh! My daughter!

My daughter! I will see her no more..oh!". We comforted her until she accepted her loss. Then when everything had settled down, the relatives requested that I should preach at this funeral. I accepted.

Since I had already paid for the Malawi Gospel Meeting e.g. registration, accommodation and transport, I requested one of our preachers here in Bulawayo, bro Lucky Ncube to go and take my place at this meeting. Bro Lucky left for the meeting and has been sending me good reports. He said over 2,000 Christians from all over Africa attended. The theme was: The church at Ephesus like us. Instead of me keeping quiet, I thought it is good for you to know because you had sponsored me. I hope you understand. Please pray for us always that we may overcome the challenges we meet and allow ourselves to be used by the Lord even in situations beyond our comprehension.
