## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

(March 2017 Progress Report, part 2)

Please continue praying for Lithule so that she can recover fully as she continues with her medication. Her trip to China has opened the spiritual eyes of some Chinese citizens that our God is alive (Psalm 18:46). This experience has also taught us lots of lessons about God's omnipresence, omnipotence, love and providence. In South Africa, Lithule's doctor was also skeptical about her quick recovery. He conducted blood tests to prove Lithule's speedy recover as soon as Lithule returned to South Africa. The results shocked him and his team because they were too true to be believed. They indicated that her kidney function was at 30%. Guess what? Lithule's doctor is now in contact with Dr Currie in China so that he may attain more knowledge in order to save many people

burdened with kidney complications.
