# Are You Open to Doing What Jesus Did? by David Shannon

What did Jesus do when He came to earth? "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost" (Luke 19:10). What did Jesus do? Jesus loved us while we were separated from Him (Romans 5:8). He came to the earth to find us and to die for us. We were lost and He searched for us. Because of Jesus we can be saved. It isn't a far stretch. It isn't like trying to do the impossible.

As a result of what He did, our Savior and our salvation isn't far from any of us! Paul introduced God to those of Athens by describing their need to search for Him. Paul said, "so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us" (Acts 17:27).

Jesus came to find and save us, but we also learn that we are to seek and find Him. He assures us that He isn't far away from any of us! Are you open to finding Him? Are you open to helping others find Him? Do you want to be like Jesus? Do you want to seek and save others? One might say, "I can't save others, only God can save." It is correct that there is only one Savior, but He gives us the responsibility to be involved in others salvation. In that sense we help save others. Listen to Paul's words to Timothy, "Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you" (1 Timothy 4:16).

Let's summarize how to be open to evangelism:

Make sure you are saved.

Make sure you embrace and submit to God's doctrine.

Make sure others have an opportunity to hear God's doctrine (teachings).

Invite others to your Bible class on Sunday morning.

Invite others to worship.

Keep 5 names of those you want to see become Christianson a post-it-note in the front of your Bible. Pray for them, seek them, and encourage them.

Use your gifts and abilities to magnify Christ. Give your life in service to God (Romans 12:1).

Believe, really believe, that no one is far from God if they will begin to seek Him.
