Report from Nqobizitha and Jacob

Greetings in the mighty name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, hoping this report finds everyone well.
 We would like to thank you very much for the continued support in all the Lord's work and also food relief that continues to save lives as the Country is facing a forty year record dry season this year, with many Provinces having received little or no rainfall.

On the first week of the month we had a breakdown of our truck which is our reliable transport, the work on the truck took 4 days, we would like to thank you very much for funding the fixing of the truck that helps us accomplish a lot of work for the Lord. We sincerely appreciate.

After getting our truck back on the road, we had to go to Mtshabezi for the burial of one of the Church leaders there, the mortality rate continues to be very high especially in the rural areas, where there is also a challenge as sometimes we have to travel to most drought stricken areas and the gathered mourners do not have food.

The second week of the month we distributed 60 bags of mealie meal to the needy brethren in Thuthuka and Mganwini Congregations, the brethren there expressed their sincere gratitude saying words cannot describe how thank-

ful they are for the charity you continue to give in their time of need, they pray that the Lord will give back the measure pressed as you take out to save so many families here in Zimbabwe.

The third week of the month we worshipped with Bulawayo Congregations, were we had our blessed combined Sunday Service with all the Bulawayo Churches of Christ, It is so humbling to see that the unity of purpose in Christ continues to be there in the Church, and then on the last week of the month we worshipped with the local Congregation as we prepare for another big event the Ladies Lectureship.

Thank you very much for all the hard work you do there in supporting the Lord's work, May the Lord bless all of you.
