MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

We have been very busy indeed almost everyday since I came from South Africa last week. We distributed food to two congregations. We attended to three funerals including that of a three year old. We also attended a wedding and baptized a 25 year old lady. We give all praise to the Lord! Since Monday we have been preparing for the ladies annual Matabeleland Gospel Meeting . It started on Thursday and will end tomorrow. It is being held at Bulawayo Central Church of Christ. I

have also been driving to the rural areas to fetch firewood for cooking. So far, almost 200 ladies have arrived for the meeting from various congregations in Matabeleland Provinces. However, a bus carrying some ladies from Binga to the meeting on Wednesday veered off the road when approaching a narrow bridge at Manjolo and fell into the river and lay on its side. Fortunately the river is dry otherwise all 12 ladies were going to drown. Many were slightly injured but one lady from Ma-

sikili Church of Christ was seriously hurt and rushed to Binga Hospital where she is admitted. We are currently requesting brethren to kindly donate whatever amount they can so that we may assist this sister in Christ. We do not know for how long she will be in Hospital. She is currently unable to talk. She needs our prayers!
