## Who Is Your King? by Tim Dooley

In 1 Samuel 1-5 we find the corrupt sons of Eli, priests, unwilling to heed their father's instructions. They cause the children of Israel to despise the sacrifices of the Lord. Then the Philistines slaughter the Israeli army and carry off the Ark of the Covenant. In the midst of all this God is still faithful to fulfill His will, keep His promises, and He providentially raises up Samuel to be a prophet and a priest.

Then, in chapters 6-10, Israel, who has never been satisfied with the leadership and awesome power of the Lord, desires an earthly king to rule over them. He had guided them out of bondage and into the Promised Land. He had set over them righteous representatives to lead them (Moses, Joshua, the Judges, and now Samuel), yet they continued to rebel. Now they

want a king like the nations around them.

Let me posit this question, "Whose side are we on?" If not on the Lord's side we are His enemy. But He will conquer and every enemy defeated (Matthew 11:30). "Furthermore, we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?" (Hebrews 12:9).

While we are often hard on the children of Israel maybe God is trying to get us to see our own nature. He has provided us with divine, kingly leadership in His Son. But that isn't good enough for most people. He is King of kings and Lord of lords! Will you allow Him to rule your life? Here's a test...have you and are you obedient to and subject to Him? ## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

### **APRIL 2019 MONTHLY REPORT : PART 1**

We send greetings from Zimbabwe in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We hope that you are doing well in the Lord and that you will enjoy reading this report.

During the month in review, my wife Stella and I crossed the border to South Africa for medical check up as we always do. I was really surprised by what my doctor told me concerning controlling or reversing my diabetes condition. Dr Jane Foster said: "Velaphi, the first thing you must do to control your diabetes is to keep stress in check." I said, Doctor, what has stress to do with my diabetes? She then said: "because the daily demands of living can drive up anyone's stress to abnormal levels. For

example, living in a state of high anxiety most of the time encourages the production of "fight or flight" hormones that increase glucose levels. People who are chronically stressed are also less likely to eat healthy, exercise and get enough rest. Therefore, Velaphi, if you're tense most of the time, try to find ways to relax and calm down for the sake of your health. Meditation, breathing exercises, and other forms of physical activity can also help."

My brothers and sisters, what Dr Foster said reminded me of the words of our Lord Jesus Christ. The secret really is not knowing these scriptures or memorising them but putting them into action or practice. Sometimes our modern doctors or philosophers claim to have

discovered new ways to solve problems which face us today. But the real truth is: if we read our Bibles with understanding, we will begin to discover that God has always provided us humankind with answers to all our modern challenges. It is true that the Bible contains the mind of God who has all answers to all our problems. That trip to South Africa actually opened my eyes because all along I thought that one could only control diabetes by following a good diet with more vegetables, less protein, less carbs and abstaining from sweet and fatty foods, exercising and taking prescribed medication all the time. Now I know that keeping my stress in check also helps a great deal in controlling my diabetes.
