Believe and Have Eternal Life *by Tim Dooley*

The beautiful prayer of the Lord before his death provides for us the key to heaven and eternal life. Jesus desired for everyone who would be saved to be one, united, even as the Father and the Son are One! But to be one with the disciples of Jesus, with Him, and with the Father, one must believe in who God and the Son are. Pilate asked Jesus if he was King of the Jews (18:33). When he was presented to the people Pilate said, "Behold the man!" (19:5). And when Pilate had the title "King of the Jews" written in Hebrew, Greek, and Latin and had it posted above the cross the Jews wanted it changed to say "He said he was..." Friends, Jesus said, "And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent"(17:3). But saying you know, or acknowledge, who he is will not save you (Matthew 7:21-22 and

Luke 6:46). To know him is to obey him.

Yes, eternal life comes only to those who know God and His Son. Following the resurrection Jesus showed himself to the disciples, but Thomas, being absent, said he would not believe unless he saw Jesus for himself. Many make similar claims today but Jesus told Thomas a week later, "Blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed." John says the things written in his epistle alone were enough to prove that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of God. And that believing in his name would give ever lasting life. The atheist will be lost, any religious unbeliever will be lost, and those who do not obey him (don't know him) will also be lost. Believe, obey, and be faithful. [Tim]

March Monthly Report: Part 3

Time is flying we have already gone past the first quarter of the year and the Lord has been with us we have already managed to accomplish a lot of work so that name of our father in heaven can be glorified.
