Boast in the Cross of Christ *by Mike Johnson*

A cross is a visible icon. There are crosses on display all around us. People wear them on a necklace or a bracelet. They appear as stickers on car windows, store windows, and certainly on some church building windows. It certainly seems to be an appreciated image.

However, this symbol is often displayed in the midst of ungodly activity. People wear them while participating in all kinds of sinful actions. I have seen crosses around the necks of people who are cursing and swearing. I have seen crosses in the possession of people who are drunk and stumbling around from the effects of the alcohol. And, I have seen images of policemen arresting someone for a crime they have just committed while wearing a cross.

This seems to me to send a mixed message. On the one hand, it is true that the cross symbolizes

the defeat of sin and the forgiveness of sinners. On the other hand, the display of the cross while in the middle of ungodly activity is hypocritical or, at least, misunderstood. Do these people think that cross allows them the freedom to do whatever they want and be forgiven anyway?

Paul did proclaim in Galatians 6:14, "But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ..." He was not an arrogant man. He never boasted in his own accomplishments. However, he was willing to boast in the one thing that really mattered—the cross of Jesus!

So, what does it mean to boast in the cross of Jesus? The word translated "boast" has at its base the word for "neck." It means "to hold the head up." Paul admits that there is only one thing that gives him real confidence and that is what God has done through Christ. Now, I can boast in that

March Reports from Preachers in Zimbabwe:
Report from Jacob and Nqobizitha, Part 1
 Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ hoping this report will find everyone well. We are already in the fourth month of the year and time is flying. We thank the Lord for all the work that has been accomplished for His Glory even through hard times for we know nothing can separate us from the Love of God Romans 8vs 35.
 It is very humbling to see most of our rural brethren are still holding steadfast to the true doctrine.
 On the first week of the month, we worshipped with the Congregation in Zhilo about 100 km out of Bulawayo. We had to drive back

to Zhilo in the middle of the same week to bury one of our longest serving sister in Christ who passed on. It is always a reminder we have a better home that awaits us.
 The second week of the month we broke the bread with the Congregation in Mtshabezi about 90km out of Bulawayo where we had to make an emergency visit as most of our brethren there lost homes and their fields where flattened by the floods. We also took 35 bags of Mealie meal and also cooked lunch to do feeding in the area, the needy brethren sent messages to say Thank you very much for the continued love you have shown may the Lord bless everyone and give back every hand pressed down.
