## The Lord Knows the Heart and Those Who Are His *by Tim Dooley*

The old saying goes, "You can fool some of the people some of the time, but you can't fool all the people all the time." We are often very good at putting on a facade and fooling others, but we need to remember that we cannot and will not fool God. "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap" (Galatians 6:7). And be sure "your sins will find you out" (Numbers 32:23). The saddest thing is that some have fooled themselves into thinking their hearts are right with God when God knows the true nature of our hearts.

While King Saul ignored the true causes of his troubles, God saw everything clearly. So many of us need to do some serious introspection and consider the true nature of our hearts in

humility and fear. Only when we clearly see our hearts as God sees them can we begin to understand God's will for us.

As Saul pursues David in an attempt to kill him, David is afforded an opportunity to kill Saul a cave. Yet, even though he is encouraged to do so by his men, David refuses to "put forth mine hand against my lord; for he is the LORD'S anointed" (1 Samuel 24:10).

An important spiritual application for us to remember is that Jesus declares those who are not with Him, are against Him (Matthew 12:30). In other words; those who are not faithfully serving the Lord are putting forth their hands against the Lord's anointed. The Lord knows our hearts and who is on the Lord's side. Are you faithful? #### **Baptism**

We are happy to inform you that six souls obeyed the Gospel Truth and were baptized during the month in review. This always brings us great joy when sinners surrender their lives to our sovereign Lord. We give all praise to our Lord!

#### **Visitors**

Zimbabwe in general is a hospitable country. We love our visitors. We were blessed last month when many visitors from some congregations in the United States descended on Zimbabwe. They came to teach, preach and motivate us to continue working in the Lord's vineyard. They also

encouraged many Christians in the rural and urban areas to be fruitful and remain faithful. They taught 93 men at a Leadership seminar at the WBS Office and taught others at brother Dorian's house. Some visited rural congregations and distributed food to the needy and candies to children. Some also taught teenagers in the evenings. We say to you: well done and please come back again in great numbers next time. Stella and I are almost through in extending our house which will accommodate many overseas visitors when they come to Zimbabwe for their extended evangelism programs.

#### **Lupane Ladies Meeting**

The annual Ladies Bible Lectureship in Matabeleland was held at Lupane from 25-28 April

2019. It was attended by almost 200 ladies. The theme was: Lord, Fill up my cup - Psalms 23:5, 22:5. Lessons presented included: Rising up for God's Work and Not forsaking our first love. It was good to see Christian ladies organizing and encouraging themselves in unity of purpose in serving our Master.
