What Do They See? (Acts 3-5) by Tim Dooley

As wonderful as the miracles that were performed by the Holy Spirit through the apostles were, the lives of these men and the disciples was also impressive. The boldness of Peter and John was so evident that the Jewish leaders "took knowledge" that they had been with Jesus. Their boldness is a repeated theme in Acts chapter four. The disciples were also united, they were one, and Jesus had promised that all men would know that they were his disciples if they had love one for another (John 13:35). Also notice that these men rejoiced that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for Christ.

What is it that those who live within our circle of influence see when they take notice of our lives? Do they see disciples of Jesus? Do they see boldness, love, unity, and rejoicing, even in trials and persecutions? This doesn't mean that we should go out and invite trouble in an attempt to show ourselves. But as Paul would write, "all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (2 Timothy 3:12). What do they see when they take notice of our lives? They are watching, and so is He! 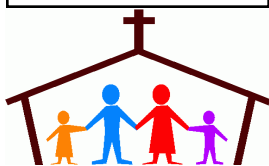
