#### **Economy**

Water shedding  
The Bulawayo City Council will from now onwards introduce a 48 hours water shedding in all areas of the city. This has been necessitated by the critical level of water in all adjacent city dams. The effects of the current drought are now beginning to affect many areas of the country. In some rural areas farmers are already beginning to lose many cattle due to shortage of water.

#### US Embassy

The United States of America has opened its US\$292 million embassy compound in Harare, a structural behemoth believed to be one its largest embassies in Africa and beyond.

US Ambassador to Zimbabwe Mr Brian Nichols, said the new embassy symbolised the United States’ ongoing and durable commitment to the people of Zimbabwe.
