Be Angry, But Don't Sin by Neil Richey

There are times, because of my own stupidity or the lack of thoughtfulness of another, I become angry. What about you?

It is obvious that in his Ephesian epistle, Paul tells the reader that it's o.k. to "be angry". Furthermore, he reminds the reader that anger must be expressed appropriately—"sin not".

It gives me great comfort to know that even God becomes angry. Repeatedly through the Old Testament we find verses like, "and God's anger," "and the LORD's anger," and "the anger of the LORD."

Some 375 times in the Old Testament alone we find references to God being angry. Add to that, even the Lord, Jesus became angry. In John 2, when Jesus entered the temple he observed that the house of God had become a house of merchandise. Consequently, Jesus made a scourge and drove them all out of the temple. Jesus was angry.

So, it's o.k. to be angry. Even God and Jesus were angry at times. However, it's never alright to be angry and sin.

While anger is not a sin, it can certainly lead us to sin if it's not dealt with properly. It's interesting how Paul concludes Ephesians 4:26. He says, "let not the sun go down upon your wrath."

What does this mean? Are we literally not to let it get dark outside while remaining angry? If that's true, what do we do if we become angry while it's already dark outside?

Another way of stating what Paul said is, "let your wrath [anger] subside quickly." Why? Because anger can quickly turn to hatred toward the object of one's anger.

In J.W. Shepherd's commentary on Ephesians he said, "He who cherishes angry, bitter, or vindictive feelings in his heart toward another will soon come to feel a hatred that will destroy all the pure and holy influences of the soul, and destroy the peace of the bosom in which it dwells, and the happiness of all around."

In context, Paul goes on to say, "Neither give place to the devil" (Eph. 4:27). If I hold on to my anger, then the devil wins—he takes control. I'm reminded of what James said, "resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (Jas. 4:7). It may only be for a short time, but he will leave. Resist the devil because he wants you to dwell with him in spiritual bondage.

The Devil loves to see God's people full of destructive attitudes and actions, resentment and rage. You see, uncontrolled anger is like a toxin that the devil never tires of.

Be angry, but don't let your anger turn to sin.
