MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

April Monthly Report: Part 2

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ hoping this report finds everyone well as we continue working in the Lord's vineyard. Time is running fast. We are slowly approaching half of the year, we would like to express our sincere gratitude for all the support for the Lord's work here in Zimbabwe without you we would have never accomplished all the work and everything done for the glory of our Father in heaven. On the first week of the month we worshipped with our local Congregation encouraging one another to hold on to the true Gospel as we know there are many false teachers who are continuously leading many astray.

On the second week of the month we continued

working in the drip irrigation gardens in Redwood about 50 km out of town. Drip irrigation continues to be a very important part for the livelihood of our fellow rural brethren because the most parts of the country received little rainfall. With drip irrigation our fellow Christians continue to farm using less water and with more yields. Thank you very much for the farming system that you introduced and it has saved lives spiritually and physically.

On the third week of the month we visited the Congregation in Bayethe about 160km to and from Bulawayo. It is with great joy to let you know that the work in the rural areas continues to grow with many of our rural brethren starting to know the mission of the Church. We also distributed 30 bags of Mealie meal to our needy rural brethren.

They sent messages to say thank you very much for being there for them in their time of need, May the Lord bless all of you.

On the last week of the month, there was our annual big event the ladies Lectureship it was held here in Bulawayo. We thank you very much for the support on the event we had many women coming from the rural Congregations and other areas. It was very successful and fruitful for the Church growth.

Thank you very for the continued hard work you do that side. We pray that the Lord will continue to strengthen our partnership and everything done for His glory.
