Why Do The Righteous Suffer *by Tim Dooley*

When we are suffering, it is common nature for us to ask, "Why?" (Psalm 73). "Why is this happening?" "Why won't it go away?" "Why did God allow this to happen to me?" Sadder even are those who, on such occasions, blame God and turn their backs on Him and walk away. Paul gives some great advice and perspective in the beginning of 2 Corinthians concerning our attitude toward suffering.

First of all, he says that when we suffer and are comforted by God then we are able to comfort others who are suffering (1:4). It is important to remember that living Christian lives is predicated upon our emptying of ourselves (Matthew 16:24) and serving others (Matthew 25:31-46). He wanted the Christians at Corinth to comfort the man who had repented and confirm their love toward him

(2:7-8).

Secondly, we gain strength through our ministry, for God and toward others, to "faint not" (4:1).

Thirdly, the greatest comfort comes through the ministry of preaching and sharing the gospel of Jesus and while doing so Paul says, "We are troubled...but not distressed...perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed" (4:7-9).

Considering all that Paul had been through it is amazing that all was but "light affliction," but that it worked for "a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory" (4:17). How are you using your suffering to serve God and others?

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Our preaching trip to Binga was a resounding success. The roads though to Binga were very treacherous with innumerable potholes. We left Bulawayo at 4am and arrived at 4pm after driving for almost 500 kms. The brethren there chose to have two separate Gospel meetings because of the distance and people in the rural districts do not have money as they have not yet sold what they are harvesting. One gathering was at Masikili in Msenampongo and the other at Hwayibhetshu near Lusulu. Over three hundred villagers attended these Gospel meetings which were held from Friday up till Sunday. We preached during the day and also at night. We also helped them with food which we brought from Bulawayo but we bought goats for relish among the local villagers. Each goat cost

\$50 and we bought three. We also distributed used clothing which was donated by Dorian and Cheri and Partners for Africa. We realised that there is real need for such clothing in Binga as many kids who came to the meeting had no shoes. One boy aged 4 came to the meeting naked. This really tore my heart apart because I just could not fathom seeing a child coming to the meeting naked. His parents are very poor because his father is blind but very dedicated to the Lord. We managed to quickly give this child some warm clothing and he was very happy indeed. Glad to see this little boy smiling! We praise the Lord for the seven souls who turned their lives to the Lord during our preaching and were baptized. Our hearts leaped with joy when two old men around 85 years of age

were among those who obeyed the Gospel Truth. It looked like salvation is what they were looking for in their lives. We had to leave early on Monday because our left rear shock absorber for our car had collapsed. So we had to drive very slowly back to Bulawayo. Otherwise the trip was really worth it. We thank our brothers and sisters at Rainbow who supported us financially to make this great trip possible. May the good Lord bless you! We now understand why the apostle Paul had to undertake the first, second and third missionary journeys. He did it in order to fortify the faith of the saints. "Then after some days Paul said to Barnabas, "Let us now go back and visit our brethren in every city where we have preached the word of the Lord, and see how they are doing." Acts 15:36. We think it will be imperative for us to visit the Binga congregations again next year, Lord willing. - from Velaphi's April 2017 newsletter
