APRIL 2019 MONTHLY REPORT : PART 4 Report from Jacob and Nqobizitha

Greetings in the mighty name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We would like to express our sincere gratitude for the continued hard work and support for the Lord's work here in Zimbabwe and all glory to our father in heaven.

On the first week of the month we worshipped with the local Congregation, praising our Lord in singing, breaking the bread and studying Word .

The second week of the month we visited the Bayethe Church of Christ about 90km out of Bulawayo where we had a blessed

Sunday service there, preaching Christ on the cross as a result 4 people obeyed the Gospel of our Lord and were baptised.

We travelled to Zhilo on the third week of the month about 100 km out of Bulawayo, it is with great joy to let you know that our rural brethren continue holding steadfast to the true Gospel of Christ even through the tough times in the Country, most of the area are already in a severe drought. We also distributed about 60 bags of Mealie meal to the needy brethren there, they also sent their message of thankfulness for the charity you continue to give in their time of need 2 Corinthians 8:1-5, and may the Lord bless all of you.

On the last week of the month there was another annual big event, the ladies Lectureship. We thank you very for supporting such an fruitful programme as many of the rural ladies benefit in the knowledge of the true Church worship, Titus 2:1.
