With his eyes fixed on his phone, he stepped on the snake, which immediately sunk its teeth into Malone's leg in defense. Feeling the sting, Tim jumped away in horror. It's important to watch our step. Getting distracted and focused on the wrong things can end in disaster. Scripture gives us a great deal of guidance in the way we should walk spiritually. We are told to walk:

In a matter worthy of the calling and of the Lord (Ephesians 4:1; Colossians 1:10; 1 Thessalonians 2:12).

In the light (Ephesians 5:8; 1 John 1:7).

As wise men (Ephesians 5:15).

With Christ (Colossians 2:6).

In truth (2 John 6; 3 John 3-4).

It's vital to carefully walk according to Scripture. Of course, we also need to make sure we don't step out in danger. Scripture instructs us to keep from walking

According to the flesh (Romans 8:4; 2 Corinthians 10:2-3).

According to the world (Ephesians 2:2).

In futility of mind (Ephesians 5:2).

In darkness (1 John 1:6; 2:11).

When we get distracted by the worldly things of this life, we are the most vulnerable to that old crafty serpent. As we move towards the Lord, let's be sure to watch our step and keep our eyes fixed on Jesus (Hebrews 12:2).
