However, Jesus assures us that magnification began first with his willingness to suffer humiliation.

Last week Jason helped us to remember that the greatest in the kingdom are servants. Jesus came to serve (Matthew 20:28) and because of his obedi-

ence to the Father he was exalted (Hebrews 5:8-9). He promised his disciples that they would have to serve others to be counted as great in the sight of God (Matthew 20:27). Humility and service are the keys to the ultimate goal of exaltation (James 4:10).

I had a safe trip to South Africa. I was examined by Dr Sparke and a dietician, Dr Woodland. The results were very good. Dr Sparke had to remove some medication from the list which I was taking because she said my health had improved compared to my last visits. Guess what? My dietician Dr Woodland advised me to take an avocado seed, crush it, put it in a glass and pour warm water and then put it in the fridge and drink water from this glass now and then. He said this would help lower my blood sugar levels. After doing this for sometime, the results will surprise me. Well, the taste of the pudding is in the eating. I will try it and see

how it works and let you know the results. Thought to share this information with you.

I came back last Saturday. Then on Sunday morning I attended a funeral of a 92 year old Christian lady at West Park Cemetery. After that I went to preach at McDonald congregation.
