The God of All Blessings *by Tim Dooley*

For a basic understanding of the letter to the church at Ephesus one can simply divide the book in half:

In the first three chapters consider what God has done for you. He has blessed us with all spiritual blessings (1:3); predestined us (1:5); made us acceptable, redeemed, and forgiven (1:6-7); made known to us the mystery of his will (1:9); gave us an inheritance (1:11); made us alive from the dead (2:1); gave us a place to sit with Christ (2:6); brought us near to Him by the blood of Christ (2:13); made us citizens of His kingdom (2:19); and gave us knowledge through the written, inspired word (3:4).

In chapters four through six Paul then enumerates what our response to God's love should be. We should walk worthy of our calling (4:1); keep the unity of the Spirit (4:3); put off the old man and put on the new man (4:22-24); work to give in serving those in need (4:28); be kind (4:32); have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness (5:6-12); be understanding of God's will and be filled with the Spirit (5:15-18); be thankful and submissive (5:20-21); and conduct ourselves as faithful Christians in every earthly relationship (5:21-6:9).

Finally brethren, be strong and put on the whole armor of God. Considering what God has done for you, how should you respond to Him? [Tim]

## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

I am happy to inform you that I arrived back home yesterday from my annual medical check up in South Africa. Blood tests were done and nothing amiss was detected save for my eyes. After going through several medical checks on Tuesday, my doctor referred me to an optician who in turn referred me to an ophthalmologist. Eye tests were done on Wednesday and Thursday respectively. Then the ophthalmologist pointed out that my eyesight had deteriorated. That is: my left eye measured 24 on pressure scale and my right eye had a pressure numbering 27. He pointed out that the normal eye pressure should not surpass 22 so I needed immediate attention. Therefore, I was given two eye medications to apply in my eyes twice daily for the next three months to lessen the pressure in

my eyes. During this time, I should consult an optician who will examine my eyes to find out if this medication was working that is if pressure in my eyes is going down. Thereafter I shall be advised to buy correct eye glasses. I thank Ken and some brothers and sisters in Canada who assisted me with transport and medical fees. May the good Lord bless you. During my stay in South Africa, last Sunday I worshipped with the Lord's church in Benoni.
