We're Not Home Yet

If you travel at all you know the feeling. Trips can be rehabilitating, invigorating, inspirational, productive, memorable, or life changing. Whether for business or pleasure we know the benefits of getting away. But we also know how good it feels to get home. By the time you begin the trip home it often feels like you are never going to make it. This past week Colleen and I went to Owensboro to see Doc (Roger McAlpin). We took the motorcycle and when we left to come home we knew there was a good chance we were going to get wet because of the storm system that was moving in. We couldn't wait to get home, and we almost made it, but ended having to stop at Richwood and wait out the storm. Then we couldn't wait to get home and dry off. Yes, there's no place like home!

We know what waits for us at home and so while we often take our time leaving we often rush to get back. We may be hungry, thirsty, or even need to make a "pit stop" along the way but we know what awaits us at home so we press on. We want to get home to see our family, to be embraced by our spouse and children, and to feel a sense of peace from the dangers of the highway. We look forward to the comfort and rest of home, our own bed, easy chair and we usually need to recover for a time. We also look forward to worshiping again with our spiritual family and want to hear about how things were with everyone while we were away.

I should also explain that there is also not an ounce of trepidation at the thought of our coming home. Unlike when I was a child and was away from home and had committed some transgression to which my father had warned, "Wait till we get home," there was no fear. I knew under such circumstances that what awaited me at home was punishment for my indiscretion. My father never forgot either and I couldn't get my brother to pay the price for me.

As our thoughts centered on these things we see the parallel between coming home from a trip away and our journey toward eternity. Remember this world is not our home; we're just a passing through. Peter said we are "strangers and pilgrims" (1 Peter 2:11). In 1 Peter 1:17 we read, "And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear." We need to be as those spoken of in Hebrews 11:13 who "not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth." The Hebrew writer went on to say that we have "no continuing city, but we seek one to come" (Hebrews 13:14).

We are all traveling home. The question is clear then, what is our destination? Are we looking forward to heaven our home with the comfort, rest and peace it promises? Do we look forward to being with our spiritual family and the loved ones who are awaiting our arrival? Or do we this day find ourselves on the way home to receive punishment for our sins? Jesus paid the price for us, but so many refuse to accept His sacrifice on their behalf.

Friends, we are not home yet. There is still time to prepare and turn our lives over to the Lord. Obey His commands and find the peace that resides only with those who have been raised with Him. And then press on, be faithful, living for Him in anticipation of one day arriving home.

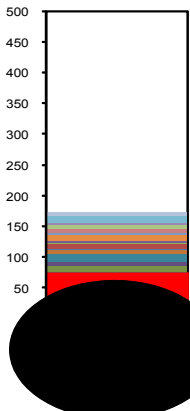

Notes from Zimbabwe Missionary, Velaphi Mlangeni

Youth Group

In Kariba, we met hundreds of WBS students. They were complaining that they had last received their Lessons from the United States six months ago. We just wish we had enough study material at our Office, in Bulawayo, we would send more lessons to these students.

Zimbabwe is approaching its economic turnaround as evidenced by recent good rainy season and renewed co-operation from the international community. Many rural farmers are now starting to harvest their corn (staple food), millet and sorghum. The livestock also looks healthy and some rivers have enough water. People everywhere are thankful to God! The International Monetary Fund will reopen its Zimbabwe Office in Harare soon and the European Union has indicated plans to strengthen its relationship with Zimbabwe. Some micro and macro factors also seem positive.
