The running gag has the dim-witted Pinky ask, "What are we going to do tonight, Brain?" His counterpart answers, "The same thing we do every night, Pinky, try and take over the world!"

Shouldn't our goal be the same while we live on this earth? No, we are not looking to selfishly seize all the power, but should we not try to lead all of our friends and neighbors to the truth? Leading other to Christ, allowing Him to rule our decisions and theirs, so that we are all a part of the family of God...what more nobler goal could there be than to "try and take over the world" with Christ's love and mercy?
