YOUTH GROUP DRESS CODE

There will be a meeting this evening after services for all youth and their parents to discuss implementation of the following policy:

The elders have decided to implement a Dress Code for youth activities. This policy should be followed at all times. It is modeled after the Rolling Hills Bible Camp Dress Code and should be familiar to most of our youth and their families. We ask that our youth and parents be patient and understanding as we implement this policy. Questions should be directed to the elders.

The policy is as follows: All clothing must be modest. Pants must be to the knee with no rips above the knee and pants mustn't hang below hips exposing undergarments. Ladies' dresses must be knee length or longer. No leggings. No T-shirts with ripped out sleeves or sides, no tank tops, midriff tops, halter tops, or see-through tops. Skin should not be visible between shirt & pants. No clothing with alcohol/tobacco advertisement or inappropriate wording.

The youth director or a chaperone may require you to change clothing if you are deemed immodest or inappropriately dressed. If you're directed to change clothing, please comply immediately or you will not be allowed to participate. Questions about the policy and the request to change clothing should be directed to the youth leader or the elders after the event is over. MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Oh! the joy of receiving relief food! Each time we deliver food to the needy in the rural areas, old ladies are usually dance expressing so much joy and gladness in their hearts. Zimbabwe is facing a terrible drought as the country has received below normal rainfall. People in the rural areas are the hardest hit as they do not have any other means to feed their families. We therefore take this opportunity to thank our loving brothers and sisters in Canada and the United States who are sacrificing so much in giving food to the hungry in the country.

This previous month we distributed 250 10kg packets of mealie meal to 200 families. We usually give some needy families more than a bag per family so that they can feed their family for

at least a week or so. We used \$1,750.00 in buying mealie meal. We were left with \$614.00 and brother Dorian Flynn donated \$1,000.00. We now have \$1,614.00 to buy 270 bags of mealie meal. We have been allowed to buy food at a discount. So, if this succeeds, we shall be buying a 10kg bag of mealie meal for \$5.00. All along retail shops were charging us between \$6 and \$7.00 per 10kg bag. This means we shall now buy more bags of mealie to feed many families. We thank the Lord. All the people who are receiving this food are very grateful indeed and they are sending their thankfulness to you!
